- ★ June 2012 -17 initial courses approved for Kansas System-Wide Transfer
- ★ June 2013 -15 additional courses will be proposed to the Board for approval

Kansas Core Outcomes Groups

- ★ Discipline-specific groups with representation from each institution, responsible for examination of courses, articulation of learning outcomes for courses in system-wide transfer

The KRSN System

- ★ System's 3-course prefix followed by a 4-digit course number for approved courses for transfer
- ★ Assigned to each course that has been approved for transfer
- ★ Allows for tracking in data system
- ★ Each institution retains its original course number
