



Legislative Update

1. Non-Budget Legislative Items for 2016 Session

- Removal of the JCCC exception from postsecondary education performance-based incentives fund, was as a one year proviso in budget last year needs to be put into statute permanently
 - HB 2483, rolled into HB 2622 as a conference committee report
- Additional revenue for the Kansas Law enforcement training Center (KU)
 - SB 335, rolled into HB 2696
- KUMC University Police Jurisdiction
 - HB 2696
- Private Postsecondary Cleanup Language, GED Credential Fee Increase (Board Staff)
 - HB 2622, passed as a conference committee report with other higher education bills
- KSU Fence Issue / Land Exchange 1 acre
 - Approved by Board, rolled into budget, SB 249
- WATC/WSU Strategic Alliance
 - SB 451, not being worked this year
- Kansas Innovation Act
 - Approved by Board, no action this session
- 60% degree and certificate attainment, HB 5011
 - Approved by Board, no action this session

 - HB 2622, passed
- CLEP, Credit for Prior Learning
 - HB 2622, passed
- Religious Freedom of Student Organizations
 - SB 175, passed
- Lifeline 911
 - SB 133, passed

 - Reallocation Proviso
- Governor's allotments
 - 4% as per the proviso
 - Cuts include board office, community colleges, technical colleges, Washburn and scholarship dollars
 - FY 17 only with no further cuts to FY 16
