

Special Collections: Data points for funding

Special Collection SB155

- ✓ Student Co-enrolled in Kansas high school (high_school = “Y”, hs_id = valid Kansas high school code)
- ✓ Student has NOT graduated high school prior to enrollment (hs_grad_yyyyymm)
- ✓ Student must be living in Kansas (live_ks = “Y”)
- ✓ Only technical courses are funded
- ✓ Courses must be tied or linked to an approved technical program

Common “Non-Funded” Reasons

- ✓ Student Submitted as not a high school student
- ✓ Student Submitted with invalid Kansas high school id
- ✓ Student Submitted as being a high school graduate based on graduation date
- ✓ Course is not technical (Tiered)
- ✓ Course is not tied/linked to a technical program

Special Collection GED Accelerator

Student

- ✓ Must be living in Kansas (live_ks = “Y”)
- ✓ NOT a high school student (hs_id = “960000” for GED)
- ✓ Date of GED must June 1st or after of the academic year being reported (for AY 2015 it was July 1st due to effective date of legislation)

Program/Courses

- ✓ Must be enrolled in a technical program (PALA)
- ✓ Must be enrolled in at least one technical course that is tied or linked to the declared technical program within the same term

\$170 (Pursuing GED)

- ✓ Has not received GED (hs_grad_yyyyymm = “000000” or GED is within AY)
- ✓ Co-enrolled in ABE or institution must keep documentation that student is pursuing GED (abe_enrol = “Y” or “E”, E=Not co-enrolled but qualifies)
- ✓ Student must attempt all 4 tests (ged_attempted = “Y”)

\$500 (Receives GED)

- ✓ Received GED from authorized testing service (ged_passed = “Y”)

\$1000 (Receives first credential)

- ✓ Receives credential from GED Accelerator approved list (credential_code)
- ✓ Receives credential within current AY (credential_date)

Common “Non-Funded” Reasons

- ✓ Student not co-enrolled in Pablo or submitted as an exception (Exception -Institution must maintain other evidence that student is pursuing GED)
- ✓ Student flagged as high school student
- ✓ Invalid credential and/or credential date
- ✓ GED Attempted and GED Passed GED not flagged properly
- ✓ Student not reported as being enrolled in technical program (PALA)
- ✓ Student not enrolled in technical course for that term
- ✓ GED date outside of valid range

Special Collection AO-K Proviso

Student

- ✓ Co-enrolled in ABE (abe_enrol = "Y")
- ✓ NOT a high school student (high_school = "N")
- ✓ Has not received GED
- ✓ Must be living in Kansas (live_ks = "Y")
- ✓ Must be flagged AO-K in Pablo

Program/Courses

- ✓ Must be in an approved AO-K program (PALA) or in an approved AO-K Healthcare Pathway
- ✓ Only technical courses are funded
- ✓ Technical courses must be tied or linked to an approved AO-K program or AO-K Healthcare Pathway

Special Collection AO-K TANF

Student

- ✓ Co-enrolled in ABE (abe_enrol = "Y")
- ✓ Must be living in Kansas (live_ks = "Y")
- ✓ Must be U.S. Citizen (Verified by DCF)
- ✓ Must be flagged TANF eligible and AO-K student in Pablo

Program/Courses

- ✓ Must be in an approved AO-K program
- ✓ Courses tied or linked to an approved AO-K program
- ✓ Tiered and non-tiered courses are funded
- ✓ Or Healthcare pathway

Special Collection AO-K Healthcare Pathways

AO-K Healthcare Pathways are considered exceptions because they are not typically in an institution's Program Inventory.

- ✓ These Healthcare Pathways must be approved by KBOR and are reviewed and approved each year.
- ✓ To receive reimbursement, the student must be enrolled in courses associated with an approved Healthcare Pathway or an approved AO-K program.
- ✓ See the AO-K Healthcare Pathways spreadsheet IRHelp provided in email on 04/07/16 for your institution's approved courses

Common "Non-Funded" Reasons

Student doesn't qualify

- ✓ Not co-enrolled in Pablo
- ✓ Not flagged as AO-K in Pablo (TANF students also need to be flagged as TANF eligible)
- ✓ Names, DOB and SSN's don't match between Pablo and KHEDS
- ✓ Student flagged as high school student

Course doesn't qualify

- ✓ Course is not technical
- ✓ Course is not tied/linked to an AO-K program or part of an approved Healthcare Pathway
