## H.R. 2353 Strengthening Career & Technical Education for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act (Perkins V) (FY18-FY23)

- State Autonomy limits Secretary of Education authority.
- Align program performance standards w/ESSA & WIOA
- Competitive funding stream innovative partnerships and practices (State Reserve)
- SAPPs would be included in eligibility (& for financial aid)
- Eliminates performance target negotiation process
- Retention & employment combined into one measure

- New hold harmless provision states receive no less than 90% than they received the previous year
- Special populations now include homeless individuals and youth with parents on active duty in the armed forces
- Concentrator students who earns 12 cumulative credits in a single program area or completes a program with fewer than 12 credits (SAPPs)
- State must publicly report and share widely actual performance on core indicators
- Comprehensive needs assessment




