


Data, Research and Planning Public Website Guide June 2021

Home Page (http://data.kansasregents.org)



The Data, Research and Planning (DRP) unit is responsible for providing data analysis support for data-driven decision-making activities of the Kansas Board of Regents.

In 1999, major changes were made to the structure of postsecondary education in Kansas when the Kansas Legislature passed the Kansas Higher Education Coordination Act. This legislation gave the Board of regents the powers and duties of higher education coordination. In addition to governing authority over the state universities, the Board was given coordinating authority over the community colleges, technical colleges, and the municipal university. As part of the additional responsibilities, the Kansas Board of Regents was given the responsibility for coordinating the federal Integrated Postsecondary Educational Data System (IPEDS) surveys for all postsecondary education institutions in Kansas, including private institutions.

The Kansas Higher Education Coordination Act included a mandate for a Postsecondary Database. Specifically, K.S.A. 74-3205d charges the Board with the responsibility to "collect and analyze data and maintain a uniform postsecondary education data base."


The DRP website has information that is available to the public while also having a secure area for institutions to upload data.

Part I - Public Access

The home page has various links to DRP ongoing research and data efforts. One current effort relates to funding for Community Colleges and Technical Colleges. The DRP home page also has a link to a program inventory search tool that we allow users to search for programs and training opportunities from the 32 Kansas public higher education systems.

Navigating Kansas Higher Education Statistics (KHEStats) Website

Kansas Higher Education Statistics (KHEStats) is a web-based reporting tool for providing access to data about Kansas public postsecondary institutions. KHEStats allows users to view trends, filter reports and perform comparison through user-friendly dashboards, graphs and charts. KHEStats Reports are generated from data collected by the Kansas Board of Regents from the state's 32 public higher education institutions (six universities, one municipal university, 19 community colleges and six technical institutions) in data collections which address enrollments, completions, demographics and other characteristics. 

Perform a basic search by entering terms and selecting the "Search" button. Names of institutions, names of programs, types of awards, or words describing programs can be used to perform a search. Results are displayed based on a search of the terms in the Program Title and Award fields, and the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) description of the programs in the data system. The display order is based on how closely a program or award fits the search term(s). You can further narrow results by sorting and/or filtering within the initial search. Sort each of the display columns by clicking on the column heading. Filter the results by entering terms into the search bars below Institution Name, Program Title, Award, or Hours.

The institution names that are displayed provide links to the website for that institution. This allows the user to learn more about the educational opportunities available at the institution.






- <u>Copy</u>: Select to copy the table of results and paste into another document (a spreadsheet will maintain the table properties).

Kansas Higher Education Data Books

The Kansas Board of Regents has published the State University Data Book since 1993. In 2015, the first Technical College Data Book was published, and in 2016, the Washburn University Data Book was published along with the first Community College Data Book of its kind. These data books include key facts about higher education in Kansas, along with the profiles for each institution which include data on finance, tuition and fees, students, outcomes, and faculty and staff.



Tuition and Fees Reports

By selecting 'Tuition and Fees Reports' on the DRP home screen, the user will be taken to the 'Tuition and Fees' page, which shows state university, community college, and technical institution tuition and fee schedules. Tuition and fees schedules go back to AY 2005 - 2006 for universities and AY 2009 - 2010 for community and technical institutions.


The six state university fee schedules are compiled by KBOR and posted in the Comprehensive Fee Schedule. The new schedules are generally available in September. KBOR also collects tuition and fee information for the Community Colleges.

By clicking on any of the links, you can see that year's tuition and fee information.

Transfer Feedback Reports

By selecting 'Transfer Feedback Reports' on the DRP home screen, the user will be taken to the 'Transfer Feedback Reports' page, which has feedback reports from Fall 2007 – Fall 2017. Beginning in 2018, this information is reported on the Transfers tab in KHEStats (stats.kansasregents.org).

The transfer reports, created from the Kansas Post-Secondary Database (KSPSD) data maintained by the Data, Research and Planning staff of the Kansas Board of Regents, are intended to give uniform information to Kansas community colleges about their students who later study at state/municipal universities in the state. For purposes of this report a student is considered a transfer student if they bring in 9 or more transfer hours from a given Kansas Community College or other transfer institution. It is possible for a student to be a transfer student from more than one institution in the reporting year. Students who transferred 9 or more hours from more than one community college are included in each community college's reports. Students with fewer than 9 transfer hours are grouped with other degree-seeking undergrads.

System Enrollments and Trends

KHEStats (<u>stats.kansasregents.org</u>) reports provides access to enrollment reporting under the "Enrollment tab. This includes reported data on students enrolled for either an Academic Year or semester (i.e. spring 2018). Charts and tables look at historical enrollment data using a variety of categories including race/ethnicity, age, and residency status. Information provided can be reviewed for the public higher education system statewide as a whole, by institution type, or for a specific institution by using the filter options provided on the charts and tables.

The Enrollment Report link found on the DRP main website points to enrollment report presentations done in the spring of 2013 – current year.



ENROLLMENT REPORTS





Kansas Higher Education Statistics (KHEStats) online reports provides access to enrollment reporting under the "Enrollment" tab. This tab includes reported data on students enrolled for either an Academic Year or semester (i.e. spring 2017). Charts and tables look at historical enrollment data using a variety of categories including race/ethnicity, age, and residency status. Information provided here can be reviewed for the public higher education system statewide as a whole, by institution type, or for a specific institution by

using the filter options provided on the charts and tables. A user can also hover any data (i.e. a bar within a bar graph) for additional information.

Additionally, historic systemwide Fall and Spring enrollments can be viewed under the "KHEER" tab, including data for total headcount, total full-time equivalency, and total credit hours. Archived reports for data 2005-2012 can be found here:



Kansas DegreeStats

This interactive online tool reviews costs and earnings data from real graduates for each undergraduate degree program offered at a public university or college in Kansas. Kansas DegreeStats will provide information pertaining to typical resident tuition, fee, room and board, books and supplies, and typical length of time to complete each degree program. Each degree program listed will also show the funding sources contributed by the individuals who completed each program such as scholarships and grants, loans, and personal investment. Through partnerships with the Kansas Department of Labor and the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, wage information about program graduates is also reported, both upon entry into the Kansas workforce and after five years of employment. Finally, a user can calculate the total loan debt or total degree investment made and review an estimated monthly payment and percent of expected annual earnings the student will spend, based on the number of years repayment selected.

Instructions on how to use the site are posted under a link in the top right corner of the page. It will teach the user how to do a search, review search results, provide DegreeStats comparison results, and other information pertaining to the website.
